For many years, the WBIDA crews had relied on a single trash dumpster location at the Wyndham Resort on Lewers Street for rubbish collection of the entire district. To increase the crew's efficiency, a second dumpster location was added in 2021 at the Alohilani Resort, and this location has recently transferred to the ABC Store on Kalakaua Avenue, between Uluniu Avenue and Liliuokalani Avenue. Thanks to each of the great



business partners for these locations — Outrigger Hotels & Resorts, Alohilani Resort, and ABC Stores — trash operations have become more effective with having service locations in both halves of the district.
