Publication Racks: Partnering with DFM, Star Advertiser

Launched in May 2022, there is a joint initiative between the WBID, the City & County of Honolulu's Department of Facility Maintenance (DFM), and the Star Advertiser to address these racks being used for trash, debris, and sleeping. The Star Advertiser donated unused containers that formerly housed newspapers, DFM refurbished the containers, and the WBID maintenance staff has inserted them into vacant spaces.



These inserts are purposely installed "backwards" to serve as a physical blockade that deters unwanted use. What an example of recycling and reuse! Installation of approximately 100 inserts is projected to be completed this summer.
